

HOBBIES/SPORTS SCRAPBOOKING CHECKLIST

Beginner Scrapbooking

- Scrapbook style photo album and refill pages (acid free and photo safe)
- Page protectors for the album you've selected
- Black pigment based pen (acid free and permanent ink)
- Paper trimmer or scissors (a trimmer will give you the straightest cuts)
- Wet or dry adhesive (photo safe and acid free)
- Photo corners (you only need these if you don't want to apply your photos permanently)
- Cardstock (acid and lignin free; ordinary construction paper IS NOT)
- Your photos (beginners might want to start with copies)
- Optional: ruler

Intermediate to Advanced Scrapbooking

- Everything from the beginner list
- Consider subscription to magazines for additional inspiration
- Patterned papers
- Vellums
- Specialty cardstocks

Tools to add:

- Circle cutter or other circle tool
- Craft punches
- Decorative scissors
- Full set of pigment pens
- Corner rounder
- True color light
- Scrapbookers paints or inks
- Dimensionals or other embellishments: Buttons, ribbon, fiber, stickers, die cuts, eyelets, brads, grommets, clips, flosses and more

Note: Items listed on this checklist can usually be found in craft and scrapbooking stores. Keep your photos safe by using acid free and photo safe products. Look for certifications like the CK OK seal.
