

TRAVEL/LEISURE INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL CHECKLIST

- Check that debit cards are accepted in destination countries
- Check that your specific credit card is accepted in destination countries
- Check if ATM card is accepted in destination countries (some countries accept 4 digit pins only)
- Obtain phone chip so cell phones works in destination countries
- Obtain electric converter kit
- Passport (check expiration date)
- Visa (if required)
- Vaccinations or Immunizations
- Vaccination certificates (if required)
- Check if allowed to travel to destination with prescription or over-the-counter drugs
- Prescription slips for medication or eyewear
- Requirements for other transportation (driver's license, registration, insurance cards)
- Driver's license, registration and auto insurance cards
- Currency conversion information and laws
- Pocket calculator for converting currency
- See Travel/Leisure, General Traveling
- Obtain advisories for destination countries
- International calling card
- Language books
- Check requirements for medical coverage abroad
- Copy passport, visa and other documents (one copy leave at home; one copy take with you in a different location than originals)
- Consider registering with consulate and the U.S. State Department
Tip: Keep these numbers handy in case of an emergency
- Know the laws of the country you are visiting
- Wallet or similar case for sales receipts
- Know exit taxes and type of payment required
- Check electric and phone requirements for laptop computers
- Take photos of common items (food, toilet, etc.) on your cell phone or digital camera to show in a foreign country where you don't know the language
